Jumonville, a premier Christian camp and retreat center, is a unique and special place with much to offer. It is best known for its landmark, a huge, white, steel cross that stands 60' high on the mountaintop. Hiking up to Dunbar's Knob to see the cross and the breathtaking view is an inspiring highlight for almost everyone who visits.

SUMMER CAMP

An extensive program of Christian adventure, sports, arts and samplers is offered each summer, and retreat space is available year-round. Co-ed, resident camps are usually one week sessions, with some shorter options for younger campers, with plenty of outdoor recreation, campfires, and inspirational opportunities.

HISTORY

Jumonville Glen was the site of George Washington's first battle, and a museum of artifacts has been preserved from the French and Indian War that followed. In addition, the state operated an Orphan School on the property after the Civil War. The beautiful campus, 19th century stone buildings, and flagstone walkways reflect the rich past of this mountaintop, and yet still offer exceptional lodging, comfort and modern conveniences.

ADVENTURE

Our numerous adventure facilities include the multi-level Challenge/Ropes Course, Commitment Swing, and the indoor Adventure Center. All of these facilities serve our most popular programs for rock climbing, individual initiatives, and teambuilding with spiritual applications. The Jumonville Adventure Program is an outstanding tool for building teamwork, self-confidence and personal growth at many levels. Jumonville has been a leader in Adventure programming and training for almost 40 years.

FAITH

Jumonville was established in 1941 and every summer since then, lives are changed as the Gospel is shared in cabin devotions, on the sports fields, or in the dining hall. Spiritual applications are integrated into adventure activities for maximum insight, & the Wednesday worship services are interactive & fun.

AMENITIES

Youth and children stay in beautiful cabins and lodges with a 4:1 camper to counselor ratio. Adults or Family Camps stay in semi private or group lodges with private baths. Guests enjoy delicious family style meals, sports and recreation, seasonal swimming, and nearby whitewater rafting, rock climbing, and caving, as well as on-site climbing walls, and Zip Line.

At the end of an exciting day, there's nothing like sitting by the campfire, looking up at the stars, and being touched by the awesome sight of The Cross of Christ shining into the night.

Phase Two is by invitation only, after successful completion of the Phase one weekend. After you are invited by the deans, you can register for Phase two. At camp, you will have hands-on experience under the guidance of experienced counselors and will stay in the rooms with the campers of iCamp 8-10. You'll gain additional experience in Bible study preparation and presentation, worship, games, evening activities, and other age level characteristics. In the afternoons, CIT's will gather for additional classroom work providing time for questions and accountability. This allows you to serve as a junior counselor by volunteering during other weeks of the summer. Once you have finished this process, you will be invited to serve as CIT for one additional week during the summer of 2012. Any CIT who chooses to attend this program must realize that they are considered a camper and as such must be accompanied by an adult who can sign them in and out. Access to a vehicle is not recommended. **Bonus: When you are accepted into the CIT program, you receive a \$50 discount toward the cost of attending, as a camper, one other conference senior high event.**

Summer Site Staff

Site staff are the core of the operation of summer camp. They provide behind the scenes support such as kitchen/dining room service, truck drivers, and office help as well as interaction with guests in the Snack Shop or as lifeguards in the Pool area. This is a great opportunity to serve God and grow deeper in your personal and spiritual life. Preference given to those 18 yrs. or older.

Program Staff Cabin Counselors & HOPE Camp Staff

A select group of our summer staff are the cabin counselors that assist with different camps each week. This includes special training in adventure activities like rock climbing, mountainboarding and facilitating age-appropriate group games and spiritual growth. This is a great opportunity to serve God and grow deeper in your personal and spiritual life. Must have one year of college or have been out of high school for at least two years.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Deans

Deans are the volunteers who carry the administrative leadership for individual camp events. Whether it's Sports Camp, Adventure Camp, an iCamp, or CAT Camp, someone must plan the schedule, recruit volunteer counselors, and supervise the event while at camp. The 50+ saints called "deans" are the key to a successful camp and vital to the church-camp-home connection.

Volunteer Counselors

There is an army of volunteer counselors who help our campers connect with each other and with God as they guide, play and supervise children and youth. These volunteers are strongly encouraged to come with their deans to the training sessions. Each year, volunteer counselors also have an important training session at camp before they meet their campers. Deans and counselors also must have proper clearances before they work in our program.

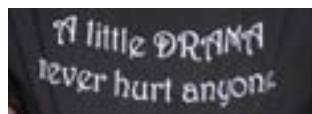

The camp fees individuals, families and churches pay help provide for daily room and board for campers and volunteer staff. The fees also help with program material and equipment costs. For some events, transportation must be provided, as well as fees paid to adventure, sports & other contractors.

Except for a limited number of campsite staff and students on Summer Program Staff, our events are generously staffed by an army of Christian volunteers. These volunteers - deans, counselors and special program resource people - make our summer program possible. Our prices are at or below the average for similar camp programs, and we do everything possible to keep costs down.

We are also indebted to local United Methodists for giving mission dollars through their churches to the Annual Conference Mission Share askings. These funds help pay the Summer Program Staff. Also, many individuals make second-mile special gifts to the camps through the Advance Specials. These gifts have made it possible to reduce the price of the Counselor In Training events, increase training opportunities for volunteers, and improve the stipend for Summer Program Staff. REFUND POLICY - PLEASE READ

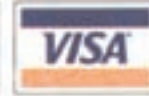
