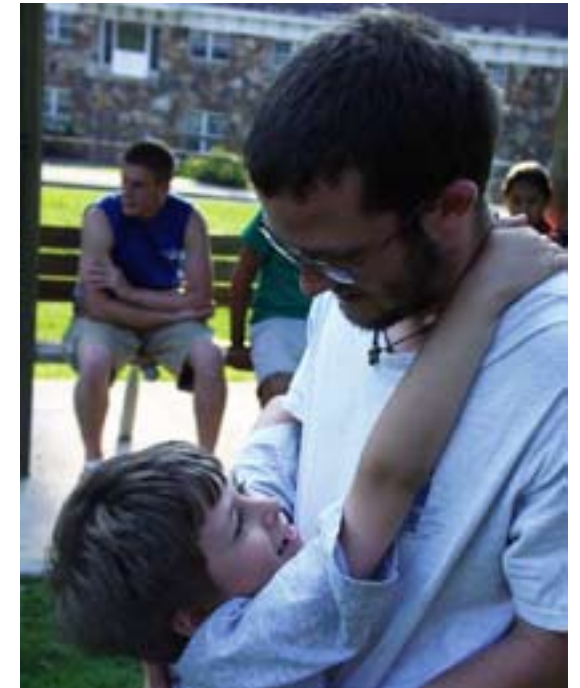

Jumonville's Ministry

Jumonville's ministry is two-fold. For years Jumonville's purpose has been to help people of all backgrounds discover and strengthen their personal faith in Jesus Christ, and to strengthen and motivate them to His service. The Jumonville staff strives to meet the needs of the United Methodist Conference, of campers, churches, families, and other guest groups.

At the same time, Jumonville provides a ministry to its staff, so that the experience is not just another summer job. Staff members are trained in community development, leadership, evangelism, and spiritual counseling while being challenged to desire to be a servant of God.

Jesus said, "Whoever desires greatness, let him be the servant of all". (Mark 10:44)

Jumonville can give you that opportunity.

Qualifications

Being a part of Jumonville's summer staff will require all of an applicant's energy to be focused on the task at hand, both physically, mentally, and spiritually.

Jumonville is looking for:

- A confident Christian faith, showing evidence of active growth.
- A willingness to participate actively in the spiritual purpose of Jumonville.
- A willingness to work hard as evidenced by good work habits and patterns.
- A positive self image and a good energy level.
- A willingness to be accountable to others, being guided by regulations established for daily work, group living, and personal conduct.



Summer staff is primarily open to college students and young adults. Program Staff applicants must have completed at least one year of college or been out of high school for at least two years. Some site staff positions have been open to students who have completed their senior year of high school.



Work responsibilities vary with each position. Some positions, such as lifeguards or health care/EMT positions, require certification. Most other positions, including counselor, need no certification. Previous experience is helpful but not necessary. Complete instruction is given during staff training. All that's needed is the capacity to enjoy people of all ages, the willingness to surrender self-interests, and the maturity to accept a personal accountability for the ministry of meeting the needs of others.



Volunteer or Paid Staff

Only a limited number of paid staff positions are available at Jumonville. The majority of those who work in our program are volunteers. Most volunteers work for a week or two of the summer while paid staff commit to the entire summer and are paid for their services.

Volunteers may offer their services by contacting the Jumonville office and completing a Volunteer Services Application. Each event's dean is responsible to find volunteer staff members for their particular programs and Jumonville tries to assist in this process as requested.



Positions Available

There are two main categories of staff positions at Jumonville. **Conference Program Staff** positions are those that serve as counselors and work side by side with campers, leading songs and games, etc... Jumonville will also be hiring some extra counselors to work primarily with at-risk kids from the local community. You will be trained in the same manner as the Program Staff with a little more information on serving the "at-risk" population. We will also be hiring some day camp staff.

Terms of Service

All staff positions include: salary (contact the Jumonville office for current rates), room and board, in-service training, Workman's Compensation Insurance, and regular time off (usually one day a week). A rotation plan for counselors provides a variety of age level and camping experiences.

How to Apply

Applications for all positions are usually available beginning in October. Interviews are essential! Site staff and program staff interviews are usually held in December & March. All applicants will be notified prior to the interviews.
