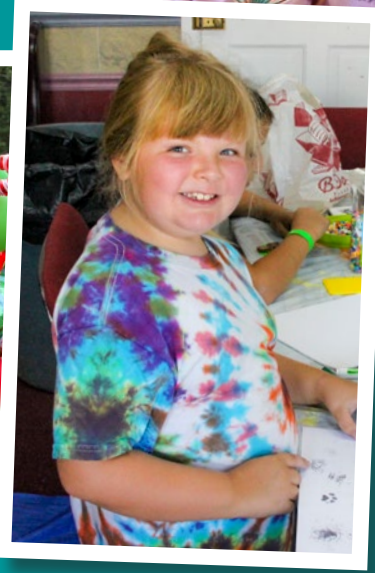

All activities will be adapted to meet each camper's individual skills and abilities while empowering them to contribute significantly to the group. Activities are facilitated by trained, qualified volunteers and staff. Most importantly at JAM, campers will learn and grow in their relationship with Christ through Bible Study, song, and prayer! Campers must be able to care for their basic needs (showering, toileting and eating) with minimal assistance and must be able to conduct themselves in a positive manner.

Campers must be self-sufficient, fairly mobile, and non-combative.

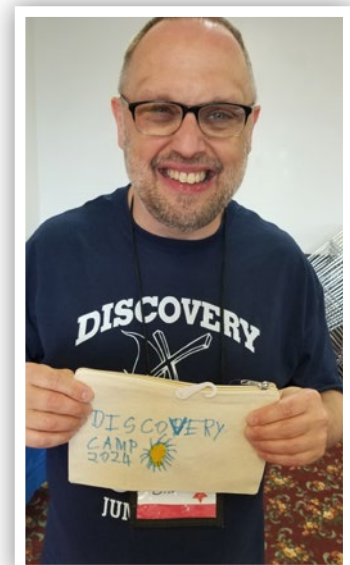

The camp seeks full-inclusion through the use of a “buddy system” to help campers with autism experience time for worship, rest, and relaxation in a safe, affordable, interactive, Christian setting capable of caring for individuals with autism.

This event runs concurrently with CAT Camp with creative programming specially designed for campers with autism and ends on Saturday morning.

A \$5 deposit is required to hold your spot. Deposits will be refunded in the form of a camp store credit.
